# Diorama de una Ofrenda de "Día de Muertos"

Date assigned: September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2016 Due: Tuesday October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2016

### Project is to be done entirely in Spanish!

The celebration of "Día de Muertos" is to remember those that have passed and are important and dear to us. We commemorate and remember these people in word and in symbol. To learn about "Día de Muertos," you are going to either commemorate a passed loved one or to research a famous person who is no longer living. You will do a "Diorama de una Ofrenda" which will include things and items that the person liked. You will use a shoebox as your display and decorate accordingly.

You will record your diorama presentation with your phone in third person (él/ella) and will explain your reasons for including specific items in the shoebox. Your written description as well as your oral presentation must all be in Spanish. Use of the "Imperfect" tense is expected: A (nombre) le gustaba el pan dulce, for example. Turn this paper in stapled to your written presentation to receive your grade.

You will be graded using the following rubric/criteria:

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The written description must be a minimum of 50 words and include the following:

- 1. ¿Cómo era físicamente?
- 2. ¿Cómo era su personalidad?
- 3. ¿Qué comida le gustaba?
- 4. ¿Qué era algo que no le gustaba?
- 5. ¿Qué hacía en su tiempo libre?
- 6. ¿Por qué era famoso/famosa? o ¿Por qué era importante esta persona?

## B. Oral Presentation \_\_\_\_\_/\_40 points.

This must be presented entirely in Spanish using the imperfect tense throughout the presentation and the video needs to be sent to my email <u>proferidiaz@gmail.com</u> to be graded. Record from your phone on <u>landscape</u> mode and presentations should be no more than a minute and a half in length (1  $\frac{1}{2}$  min.).

### C. Diorama \_\_\_\_\_/\_40 points.

This should include a minimum of six items that the person loved, labeled in Spanish, and they must also adequately reflect the theme of "Día de Muertos."

\*If necessary please ask your teacher for examples or personality suggestions. Note: if turned in early, 10 extra credit points will be earned towards your final project grade. IF LATE... ten points will be deducted each day it's LATE!
